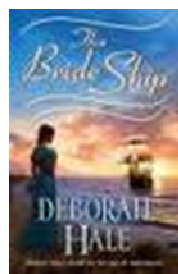


1619

- 1) **Africans arrive** in Jamestown and allowed the colony to expand the tobacco economy
- 2) **House of Burgesses** (General Assembly) **met for the first time**



1620

Bride Ship arrived in Jamestown

Single women **sent to marry** and **begin families**

Made it possible to establish a more permanent settlement



slaves

1. Africans that were **captured by sailors from Portugal** from what is now Angola.

2. Brought **against their will** first as indentured servants then slaves

3. **Worked on tobacco plantations**



indentured servants

Africans that were brought to Jamestown to **work on tobacco plantations for a period of time usually 5-7 years** in exchange for passage to America



triangular trade

The **trade pattern** in which Europeans traded goods for kidnapped West Africans



tobacco

cash crop of Virginia

often **used as money**

grown to sell for money

required **many workers** to plant and harvest



barter

to trade something for goods or services



No banks!

There were **no banks** in Colonial Virginia



House of Burgesses

1st elected law making body
in English America



General Assembly

Gave the colonists a chance
to have a say in their
government



Governor's Council

Made up of wealthy and
powerful men who gave the
governor advice



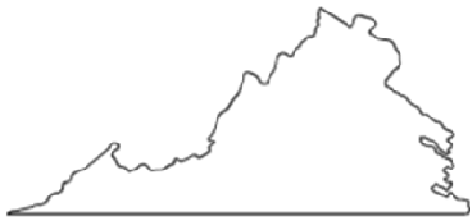
Virginia Assembly

Goods that are sent **OUT OF** the country
