
Rules for Rounding

4 or below, leave it alone 5 or above, give it a shove



Follow the steps below when rounding a whole number:

Directions: Round to the nearest **hundred**.←

Step	What to Do	Example
Step 1	Underline the digit to be rounded. (Hint: you'll know which digit to round by reading the directions!)	5, <u>6</u> 82
Step 2	Look at the digit to the right of the underlined digit. Draw an arrow to that digit.	5, <u>6</u> 82
Step 3	If the digit with the arrow is 4 or below, the underlined digit stays the same. If it is 5 or above, add 1 to the underlined digit. Write down the digit.	5, <u>6</u> 82 7
Step 4	Replace all of the digits after the underlined digit with zeros. Keep all of the digits before the underlined digit the same.	5, <u>6</u> 82 5,700 answer
